Field of Heroes Flag Display Replanting

Beginning **Monday May 1** we will start to place 7055 flags in the Field of Heroes Flag display. This is a labor of love as we place each of those flags into the ground we realize that each one represents the life of a U. S. service member who made the ultimate sacrifice. On Monday we will have local school students helping to place flags. On Tuesday and Wednesday we will need volunteers to complete the work. Work will begin at 9 am and conclude by 1 pm each day. The flag is made of 7055 red, white and blue dog tags, each bearing the name of a fallen hero. The traveling memorial flag is a moving exhibit when viewed against the backdrop of 7055 flags gently waving in the breeze. Plan to experience this unique and moving Exhibit.
